

Dear Parent / Guardian

January 2011

I would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a Happy New Year and to thank you for your support throughout the term. Last term was very busy for all concerned particularly with ensuring that The Post Inspection Action Plan is implemented fully. I am pleased to note that the new Senior Leadership Team is working well and has, already, made significant changes to curriculum and structures that will benefit all learners. All staff are working hard and it is clear that we have, significantly, moved forward during this term. The end of term was unfortunate with the snow and we had to postpone our annual Prize Evening with Mr Glyn Heulyn Roberts as the guest speaker and also our carol service at Peniel Chapel. The children were also unable to have the traditional end of term celebrations and have the opportunity to farewell with Mrs Anne Hubbard who has taken early retirement. As Mrs Hubbard was Head of the Sixth Form, the students are planning a formal farewell during this half term.

Due to the snow in December, it is our intention to postpone the staff Training Day, planned for 28th of January and have this as a normal school day. A number of subjects, already, have made arrangements to have extra lessons, or special lessons with their classes and if you are concerned in any way or require information, please contact me or the Head of Year. I have confirmed with the students that they are able to use school facilities after school every evening apart from Friday 3.15 – 5.00 where they can use the library, have a quiet place to work or have access to computers or receive extra help. We have applied to the Welsh Assembly for a grant to have an After School Club and will keep you informed of any developments.

I have spoken to the senior school and have reminded them that all external examinations planned for this half term will go ahead irrespective of weather. WJEC the Examinations Board cannot change the dates or times. It is imperative, therefore, that you follow the weather projections carefully and consider making arrangements for your child to stay with a friend in Aberaeron the night before an examination rather than being unable to come in to Aberaeron because of snow. We will ensure that we update all candidates of any severe weather warnings. I have asked everyone to consider what arrangements that might be possible and to inform their Head of Year or members of the Senior Leadership Team if there is a potential problem. I can assure you that we will do whatever we can to support you in this matter.

I hope that our new telephone system was useful to you during the severe weather as we were able to place a message stating that the school was closed due to the snow. We do, also, inform Radio Ceredigion, Radio Cymru and Radio Wales, but they do not always announce the closure. We will ensure that in the event of severe weather, we will have a message on our telephone system giving information about being open or closed. No message will mean that the school is open as usual. In the event of having to close the school during the day because of snow, we will have the children's safety in mind at all times. We are in close contact with the bus companies and will be advised by them regarding remaining open or closing.

We have a system in place where we allow Aberaeron pupils home first which reduces pupil numbers in school and alleviates some of the pressure. We check with the pupils whether they have permission to go home and will ring if there are any uncertainties. We would prefer if you contacted the school directly if you have any concerns rather than contacting your child by mobile phone as this, usually, has an excitable effect on the children which exasperates the difficulty. Once we have made the decision to close the school we will allow pupils to use their mobiles

We are endeavouring to introduce an E-mail service for parents and I am grateful to those of you who have already supplied us with E-mails. If you wish to be contacted by E-mail, and/or text message please complete the attached slip.

2. Closing School in an Emergency

We would appreciate if you would discuss closing school in an emergency with your son/daughter so they know what steps you wish them to take. This of course, will only happen in an emergency e.g. severe weather, or heating problems in school. At the beginning of this term we had severe weather indeed, which resulted in the school having to close. We apologise that the decision to close was not made in the evening, because there was no snow in Aberaeron, we had to wait until the morning.

If the decision to close is made we will contact Radio Ceredigion by 6.45a.m., to enable announcements to be made at 7.00a.m. The situation in Aberaeron and the surrounding area is unique, with bright weather in Aberaeron, but snow drifts in Synod Inn. The safety of our pupils is always our main focus when making the decision. I can assure you that we would not take any risks, with the safety of any of our pupils. Resulting from talks with Governors, staff and pupils we intend to create a place on our web site to enable pupils to carry on studying and completing school work. Some of the senior pupils kept in contact through e-mails, which is another way we may consider. If you have any ideas or suggestions on ways to improve this area please do not hesitate in contacting the school.

3. This year's **GCSE and A/AS Examinations** will be held from May 16th – 24th June 2011 but some practical / oral examinations will be held before May 16th.

4. School Eisteddfod

The School Eisteddfod which will be held on Friday, 18th February is an important school event and all pupils are encouraged to participate in the various competitions. There are competitions for Welsh speakers and Welsh learners. **All pupils attending the Eisteddfod both in the afternoon and evening must be dressed in full school uniform.** The afternoon session starts at 1.00p.m. and the evening session at 4.15p.m. It is expected that the Eisteddfod will finish between 9.30-10.00p.m.

Note

This year again the school buses will leave at 3.15 p.m. There will be no school buses at the end of the evening session and parents are asked to make their own transport arrangements. If your son / daughter is taking part in the evening session and has difficulty getting home, please inform the school in writing as soon as possible.

Meals can be purchased at the Canteen between 3.15 and 4.15p.m. by pupils and visiting adults. Both the afternoon and evening sessions are open to the public and tickets will be available at the door £4 for afternoon and evening sessions; £3 for the evening session only. This is one of the major events of the school calendar and I extend a very warm welcome to all parents to join us on this day.

5. Single School Leaving Date

There is now one single school leaving date, which is the last Friday in June in the school year in which a child reaches age 16. In 2010 this date will be **Friday 24th June**. Pupils must therefore remain in education at school or otherwise until the advertised date. Employers may not employ pupils full-time until this date.

6. Official School Uniform

I should like to draw your attention also to the official list of uniform and ask you earnestly to conform to our requirements when you are buying new items of uniform. Items of school uniform can be purchased at Box of Delights, Aberaeron (jumpers, polo shirts & ties), Elegance New Quay, Alison Jones Schoolware PO Box 180 Aberystwyth SY23 3XE (uniform@btinternet.com) and Tommy Evans Evnatech 01545580128.

Please note that pupils are not allowed to wear trainers around school. Trainers are to be worn during PE/Games lessons only.

7. Mobile Phones

I wish to remind you that whilst pupils may bring mobile phones to school in case they need to use them **after school hours**, their use **is not permitted in school** and we will not take any responsibility for phones that could be damaged or lost in school. Please note that pupils are not to bring IPOD's, MP3 players, headphones/earphones to school.

8. School Attendance

I would like to remind parents that under normal circumstances **the only reason children should miss school is if they are too ill to attend**. If this should happen we would appreciate a message by phone before 10.00a.m. on the **first day** of your child's absence. **Should we not hear anything then we will be contacting parents throughout the morning in order to confirm the reason for the absence**. We feel it is important for school to know the exact whereabouts of each pupil in order to comply with the Child Protection Act.

When your child returns to school s/he should bring a note to explain the absence more fully. If any other circumstances make it necessary for your child to miss a day then it is important that this is discussed beforehand, if possible, with the Head of Year, who will then decide if the absence can be authorised.

9. Re-sit Examinations

Please note that no re-sit entries will be made unless accompanied by the appropriate fee.

Hoffwn ddymuno blwyddyn newydd dda i bawb a diolch i chi am eich cefnogaeth dros y tymor diwethaf. 'Roedd y tymor yn un prysur iawn wrth ystyried ymateb i'r Cynllun ôl Arolwg a sicrhau ein bod yn gweithredu'n llawn. Mae'n braf nodi bod y Tîm Arwain newydd yn gweithio'n dda iawn ac, yn barod, wedi gwneud newidiadau sylweddol i'r cwricwlwm a strwythurau sydd o fudd pob dysgwr. 2. Cau'r ysgol mewn Argyfwng
